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Mental Health & Substance Abuse-Counseling Services :

These service providers provide services on a sliding fee basis. Those that take Medicaid will be noted.

Heritage Behavioral Health Center, Inc

217-362-6262 ask for intake

This is the major provider of publicly funded mental health and substance abuse services. They specialize in serious mental illness for both adults and children. Heritage also has supportive apartments. In the area of substance abuse, Heritage provides a social setting detoxification program, residential rehabilitation, intensive outpatient services and outpatient services. Heritage accepts Medicaid clients. Crises Services 24 hours a day 7 days a week are provided.

Catholic Charities

217-428-3458 ask for counseling program

Catholic Charities is the largest publicly supportive provider of mental health services for non serious mental health problems. The services are mainly outpatient counseling. They serve both adults and children. Marriage counseling is available. Services are not faith based.

Webster/Cantrall Hall: ACT Program

217-423-6961 ask for ACT or "708" program

This program provides counseling and case management services to children and adolescents who have behavioral and/or emotional problems. This does include family counseling. These services accept individuals on Medicaid.

Campion & Associates

217-423-2604-ask for "708" program

This office provides treatment and assessment services for children and adolescents with emotional and/or behavioral problems. The "708" program has a sliding fee scale. The office specializes in youth who have been sexually abused.

ABC Counseling

217-429-3855

This office provides services to children and adolescents with emotional and/or behavioral problems. Services are outpatient and include family therapy. This office has a staff credentialed in providing treatment services to a juvenile sexual perpetrator.

CHIC-Community Health Improvement Center

217 877-9117

This is the federally funded health clinic. This clinic has two counselors on site for adults and children. This clinic accepts Medicaid and the uninsured. Heritage Behavioral Health Center provides a psychiatrist that consults with the physicians on staff. One must receive their medical services from this Clinic to receive their mental health services from the Clinic.

Child and Family Connection #19

This is the beginning point for children from birth to three who have a developmental delay. This is the single point of entry into State supported services. Screen and assessments including psychological, speech, physical therapy and developmental therapy are provided. If eligible service connections are made and ongoing service coordination is provided.

Macon Resources Inc.

This is the largest publicly supported provider of services to adults and youth with developmental disabilities. A wide range of services are provided.
